Before entering Holy Redeemer Church for evening Mass, the congregation gathered outside in the Garden of Life while the pastor, Father Nathe, led recitation of the Rosary with prolife meditations.

At the end of the Mass for Life, Father introduced a member of the parish, Gerry Parmantier, RN retired, Clark County Right to Life Treasurer and Local Leader 40 Days for Life Campaign. He spoke for several minutes. *(Remarks below edited in order to add pictures and text for this newsletter.)*

On June 24, 2022 KIRO news in Seattle contacted me about a ZOOM interview later in the day regarding the US Supreme Court’s overturning of Roe v Wade and returning abortion law to the states as it was before 1973. My contact information is on the website of Clark County Right to Life (**Contact Us**) and I have been a member for nearly 50 years. I immediately called Dorothy Gill, our Vice President, also a long-time member, and suggested she do the ZOOM interview. **“No,” she said,** you will do fine if you stay on message.”

What is the message?

If you are pregnant, you are not alone.

Another heart is beating near your heart and there are **many hearts in the community** ready, willing and able to help you and your baby before and after birth. My **ZOOM interview never made it onto the evening news**. So, KIRO’s audience never got to hear **“the message”**.

Many girls and women who have abortions

have never heard “the message”. And the abortion center staff does not inform them.

Our mission at Clark County Right to Life is to provide that information and our website pages do just that...and more.

Our homepage www.clarkrtl.org includes a link to the 6-minute video *Your Life Before Birth*. And another link to former abortionists describing how abortion works to take the life of the child in the womb, not in the uterus, but in graphic pictures...still upsetting.

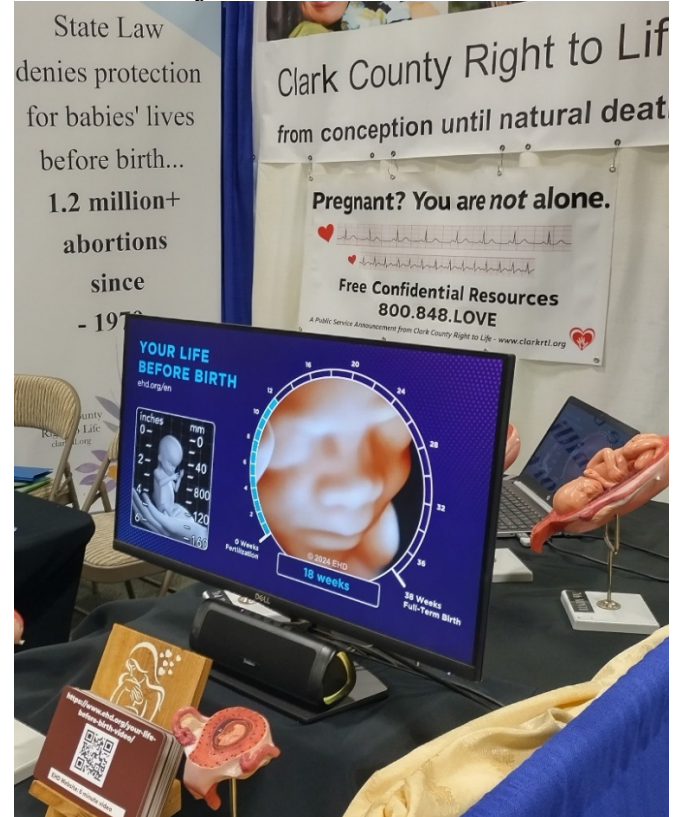
About Us shows the baby’s heart beating at 4 ½ weeks after conception.
